



**10 How should golfers be like survivors put in a lifeboat?**

The first can be done by an individual; the second, the most valuable action of all, requires successful interaction within the playing group.

**13 What are the 2 keys to high-performing groups?**

**A** Common goal

**B** Each individual exercises their responsibility to influence the others to help achieve the result.

**14 What can 'pace of play efforts' learn from a FedEx parcel or Amazon order?**

You can easily track the progress of a FedEx parcel or Amazon order, but you can't easily track progress against a target pace of play (e.g. 2hrs 44mins to here).
